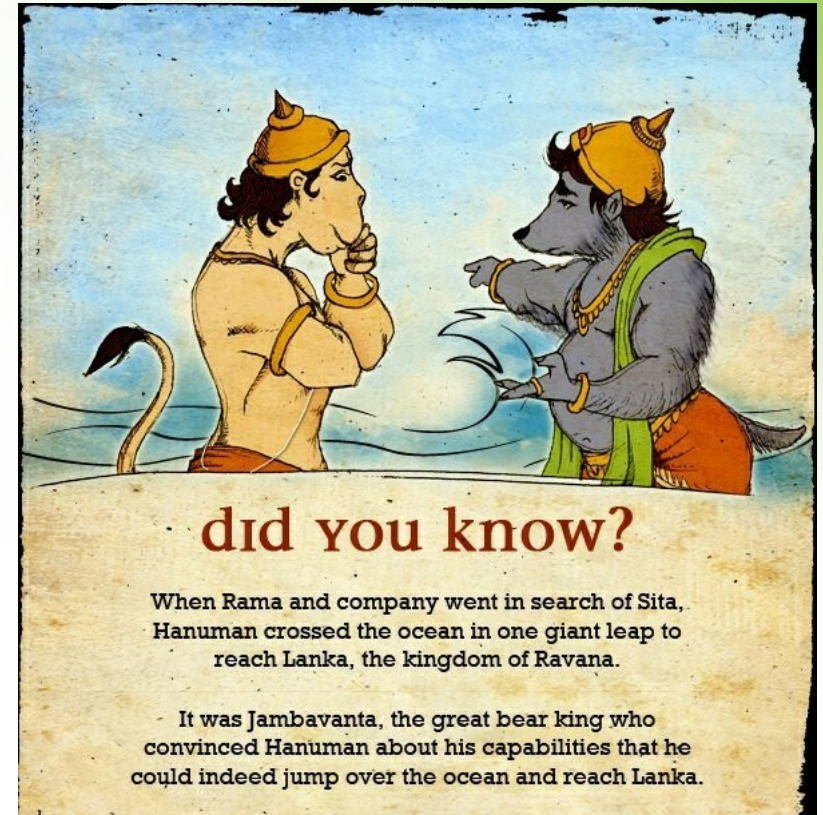


I CAN INDIA CAN

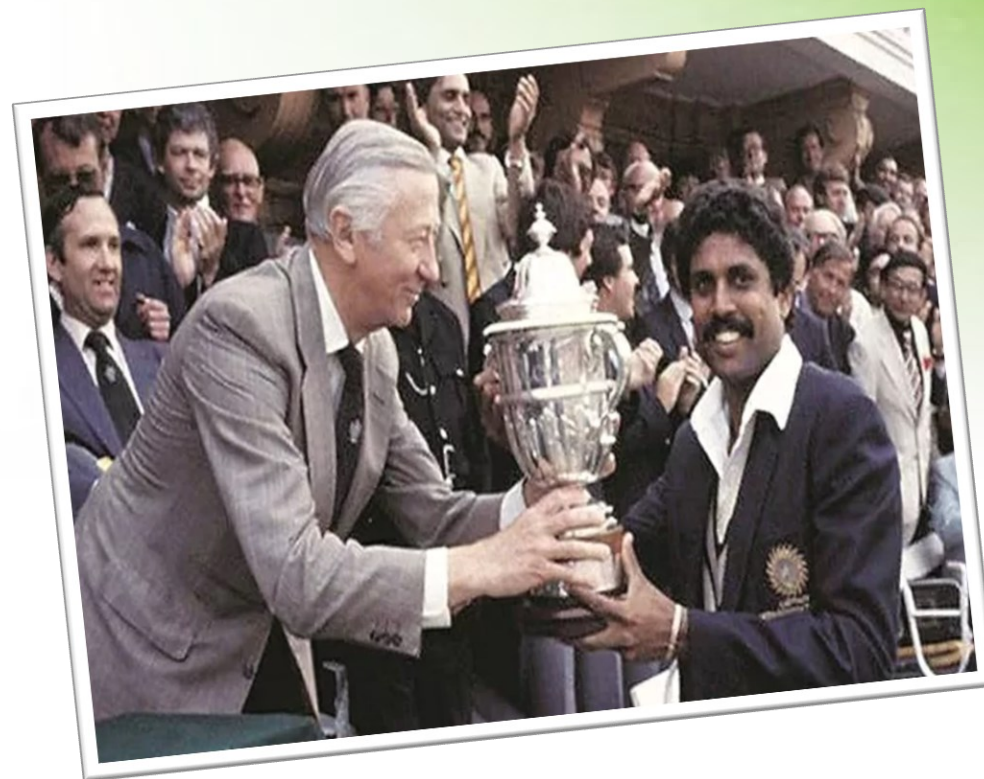
THE HOCKEY LEGACY!!

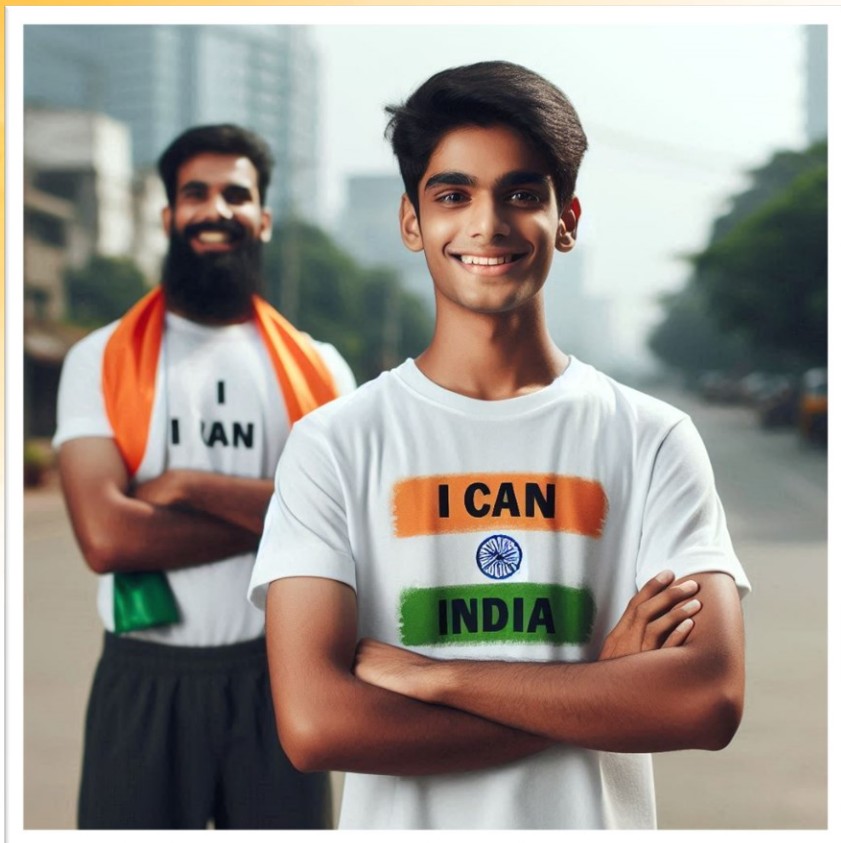
